Interns will be placed in a preschool group, and work together with the team to support the children in the learning environment. Internship will also include introduction and reflection meetings with HR (Alison Hårdstedt) to support the process of the internship.

2. To develop an understanding and participate in working with Swedish curriculum for preschools- LPFO18.
3. To have full knowledge, understanding, and capability to teach and meet the needs of all children within your care, between the ages of one to six years of age.
4. To develop an active participation together with the teaching team with special focus on children with special needs.
5. To participate in age appropriate developmental plan for every child.
6. To ensure that non-religious, non-political based activities are always presented to children, without exception.
7. To participate and implement an age appropriate theme.
8. To embrace worldwide cultures and festivals, (non-religious/non-political).
9. To meet and greet each individual child, at their eye level every day. To meet and greet each child's parent/guardian.
10. To participate together with the team in posting to Unikum (documentation app) to inform the parent/guardian of children's growth & development endeavors, outings, etc.
11. To participate in spiritual, emotional, intellectual, social & physical wellbeing of each individual in the care.
12. To participate in maintaining a clean and organized classroom
